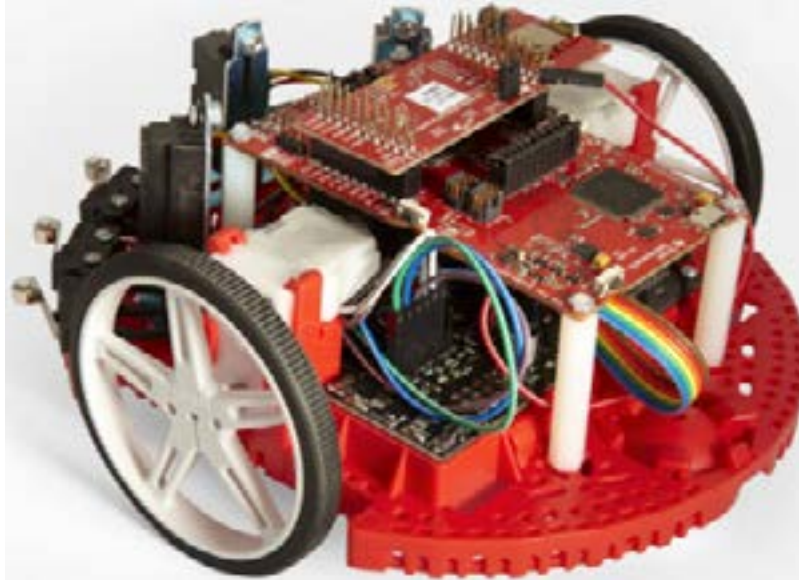


2022 SUMMER RESEARCH EXPERIENCE



Interested in Robotics or Artificial Intelligence? Apply Now for Summer Research Experience July 6-16

The goal of this free-of-charge summer research experience is to introduce high school students to research activities in science and technology through active participation and hands-on, real-world experience. The program will consist of short lectures, design, assembling, and programming taught by ECE Florida faculty. The days will run 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.

REQUIREMENTS

Students enrolled in any high school are eligible to participate. Students must be US citizens or permanent residents. Students from historically underrepresented groups are especially encouraged to apply.

- The research experience is free of charge.
- Students will be able to attend virtually via Zoom or in person in Larsen Hall on the UF campus.
- Students must be rising first-years or sophomores and have a good understanding of STEM topics.
- Students may be required to purchase materials (TI-RSLK Basic Kit for \$109) at a reasonable cost.
- Students can choose between activities in machine learning or robotics.
- Students are responsible for their own lunch.
